



Dish

Silver embossed, chased and engraved

Antwerp, 1660

Maker's mark a fruit or a fish

D : 29,5 cm

Weight : 342 grams

The wide rim of the dish is divided into six floral cartouches decorated with animals and surmounted by a shell. A coat of arms of the Rysbosch family is engraved in the centre, it probably belongs to the notary Arnold Joannes Rysbosch (1602-1676).
