Akeleibecher

Cast silver, chiselled and partially gilded.

Nuremberg , 1658-1659, Johann Reinhold Mühl, master in 1654, died in 1692

The three Blattwerk (foliage) motifs on the lid and body of the piece are hallmarked by the silversmith, identified by the letters IR in an oval. This hallmark belongs to a member of the Rauchwolff family who, between 1614 and 1669, supplied numerous small decorative elements of this type to various local and foreign silversmiths.

Austrian control mark from the 19th century.
